Remember, quilt store quality batik, bright and contrast. Directions abound. See below.

Books: *Around the Block Again* and *501 Rotary Cut Blocks* by Judy Hopkins.

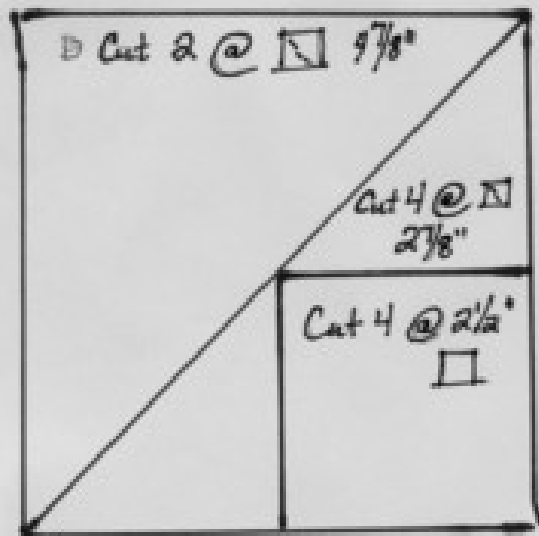
My flyer attached.

Used the same batik for the large triangle and the 2 ½" square.

For 12 exchange sets, make 48 4½" blocks. You will need
2/3 yard of the dominate color (large triangle and 2 ½" square)
1/3 yard of other (need 12" useable inches).

I suggest that you make no more then 12 sets of one color scheme. Please feel free to make more then one color scheme.

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501 Rotary cut blocks

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for 4" finished block cut as shown. Amounts
 yield 1 set (of 4 blocks) for exchange
